Title: Lifeguard

Department(s): Aquatics

Reports to: Recreation Supervisor

Job Summary

Maintains constant surveillance of patrons in the facility; acts immediately and appropriately to secure safety of patrons in the event of emergency. Provides emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services.

Lifeguard also assists with special events, aquatics programming, and other assigned tasks as needed.

Summary of Essential Job Functions

To obtain employment as a lifeguard, one has to be an excellent swimmer along with possessing certification in lifesaving particularly the Red Cross Advanced Lifesaving Certificate. Specific training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) is also one of the prerequisites for this position.

Minimum Requirements

Must be at least 15 years of age

Must possess American Red Cross Advanced Lifeguard Certification

CPR/AED Certified

Abilities Required

Be in Good Physical Condition

Must be able to work in a team environment

Represent the Chillicothe Park District in a positive manner to the public at all times
